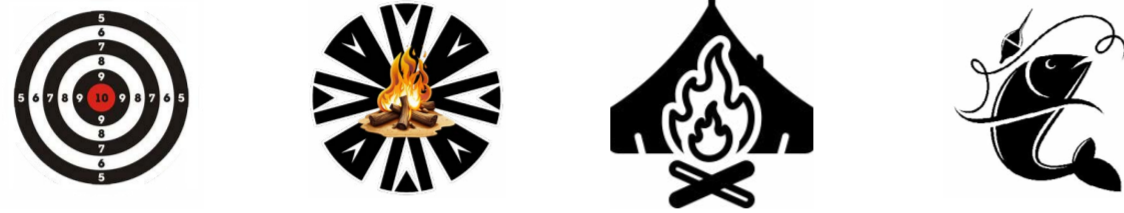


'Wilderness Games 2024'

The inaugural "Wilderness Games" event, hosted within the Underdog Crew 'Life Unplugged' wilderness camp. A decathlon style outback games, incorporating 10 events to test the dexterity and fortitude of the very best! All activities are fully inclusive and not reliant on personal fitness or sporting prowess. Our 4.5 acre site provides a weekend of exercise ranging from leisurely strolls across the site for each activity, to brisk walks... to frantic sprints as the points tally up and the clock runs down.

The Games

1) Big Carp Hunt (ongoing: Saturday and Sunday - 8pm finish)

- * Any fish over 5lb - 10 points
- * Any fish over 10lb - 15 points
- * Biggest carp caught over event - 25 points

2) Pond life (1 hour) - 20 points for competing

Mini beast pond dipping investigation. Most different species found, photographed and identified wins.

1st - 50 points / 2nd - 30 points / 3rd - 15 points

3) R/C TRACK MASTER (1 hour - 2 races per day)

Take to the racing track against other drivers for the 10-lap challenge.

1st - 50 points / 2nd - 30 points / 3rd - 15 points

4) Bush shelter build (ongoing: Saturday & Sunday)

Teams of 3 compete to make the best bushcraft shelter over the event.

1st - 50 points / 2nd - 30 points / 3rd - 15 points

5) Cook-off challenge (2-hours) 30 points for competing

Head to head challenge to cook and serve a choice of street food snacks. Winners voted by panel of judges.

1st - 30 points / 2nd - 20 points / 3rd - 10 points

6) Gel blaster wars (2 hours - 1 war per day)

Royal Rumble. 3x 15 minute death matches. (Using natural dye gel beads. All competitors get a clean white tshirt to begin.) Cleanest shirt after 3 rounds wins. Competitors MUST make contact with 4 bases each round and collect a token from ALL BASES to qualify for points.

BONUS POINT events

7) Photo scavenger hunt (ongoing: Saturday and Sunday)

Seek out and photograph as many items on the list as possible.
10 items - 5 points per item.

8) Pirate Treasure hunt (ongoing: Saturday and Sunday)

Find, and cash in, any special "Pirate treasure coins" hidden throughout the location for 10 bonus points per token. 50 Coins scattered throughout site.

9) campfire ghost story challenge (1 hour)

Best original story voted wins 25 points.

10) Music and drumming workshop (45 minutes) 20 points for competing

RULES

Participants score cumulative points through all activities, stamped and signed on a scoresheet. 1st place for each challenge wins 10 points, down to 1 point for 10th place.

For overall points tally.

Suggest things to bring

Suncream, Mosquito repellent, Wash kit & towel, Tent and mattress if bringing yourself Duvet and pillow (or sleeping bag), 2 sets of clothes and comfortable footwear. **2 White T-shirts.** Hoodie for chilly evening. Phone charger and portable light, Hygeine wipes. **NO NYLON CLOTHING** - fires do not like it!!! VERY IMPORTANT.

Snacks and Drinks

We are providing several meals per day: **Breakfast:** cereals and campfire bacon/egg baps

Lunch and Dinner: Healthy, nutritious.

Snack Ideas: Pot Noodle, hot chocolate sachets, cold fizzy or flavoured water, Pringles, biscuits etc.. THERE IS NO MICROWAVE! But we will have plenty of campfire popcorn.

Cafe money: The Onsite cafe sells a selection of cold drinks (75p a can) and sweet tubs from a machine (£1 coin). Chef's menu includes 'proper' smashed burgers (£6) and home-made stonebaked pizza (£10)
